Mayor Noble called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

## **7. PUBLIC HEARINGS**

- a. Receive public comment regarding adoption of the Stormwater Quality Management Plan for the 2015-2020 permit cycle (CC-16-13)

Development Services Director Paula Dennison presented the final draft of the Stormwater Quality Management Plan prepared by staff and a citizen committee. No public remarks were received on the draft during the comment period. The final report will be submitted to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) for approval prior to the deadline date.

Mayor Noble opened and closed the public hearing as no one was present for or against.

Staff recommended City Council approve the Stormwater Quality Management Plan and authorize the City Manager to sign the Notice of Intent and associated documents.

## **8. GENERAL ORDERS**

- a. Contract with Stillwater Medical Center to construct splash pads at Boomer Lake and Southern Woods parks

Parks and Recreation Manager Jim Scott reported on the splash pads to be installed at Boomer Lake and Southern Woods parks. Stillwater Medical Center (SMC) has issued bids for the installation of the two splash pads. Mr. Scott said if the weather cooperates, the splash pads should be operational by May 2016. Discussion occurred regarding locations, lighting, discharge of the used water and items contained in the bids. Appreciation was expressed to SMC for taking the lead in this project.

City Attorney John Dorman expressed that the contract that has been prepared is to accept a donation from the SMC Board of Trustees to fund the two splash pads. The City of Stillwater is responsible for electric and water to the splash pads. SMC will have the splash pads constructed and will then turn them over to the City to operate. Once the improvements have been made, a document will be signed turning them over to the City; at that time liability will move from SMC to the City.
