Subject: Acceptance of Electric Easement, 1600 N. Jackson Place

Purpose of Report: To request City Council acceptance of an electric easement.

Discussion: The proposed easement is to provide Stillwater electric service to a property not within the city. The owner of the property to be served has received a release from CREC to allow SEU to serve the property. The easement crosses properties under common ownership that are both located adjacent to the city limits and within city limits.

Budget Impact: The easement will allow SEU to provide billable service to an outside city limits customer.

Alternatives:

1. *Accept the easement.* Allows SEU to provide electric service to a customer outside the city limits.
2. *Do not accept the easement.* Requires SEU to provide service utilizing another route and other properties or SEU may not be able to serve the potential customer.

Recommendation: Staff recommends Alternative 1 - Accept the electric easement at property addressed as 1600 N. Jackson Place.
