Subject: 16TR01 – D: Bid Recommendation Thin Surface Overlay on City Streets and Right of Way

Budget Impact: The approved FY16 budget includes \$3,375,000 for pavement management projects. Within the pavement management budget, \$473,875 was allocated for preventative maintenance.

Alternatives: The recommended action is consistent with the approved FY16 pavement management program. If the Council would like to proceed with the program as approved, the recommended action should be approved. If the Council would like to alter the approved program, the bids should be rejected and staff directed to make changes to the program.

Recommendation: The Transportation Department recommends awarding a unit price contract to the lowest responsible bidder, Vance Brothers, Inc., in the amount of \$346,949.68 and approving expenditures of up to \$381,645 for the completion of the Thin Surface Overlay project.

Background Information: On October 19, 2015, the City Council accepted staff's recommendation for the FY15 Pavement Management Program and authorized staff to begin work on the projects. Since that time, staff has developed plans and specifications for the four primary work programs: preventative maintenance, rehabilitation, reconstruction, and deferred maintenance. The preventative maintenance includes thin surface overlays on approximately eight lane miles of asphalt streets.
