**1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER**

Mayor Noble called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

**2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

Councilor Weaver's granddaughter, Elizabeth Weaver, kindergartener at Sangre Ridge Elementary School, and Tucker Beach, 5<sup>th</sup> grader at Sangre Ridge Elementary School, led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**3. PROCLAMATIONS & PRESENTATIONS**

a. Child Abuse Prevention Month

Mayor Noble proclaimed April 2016 as "Child Abuse Prevention Month" in Stillwater, Oklahoma. Ms. Campbell accepted the proclamation on behalf of the Child Abuse Prevention Task Force and the Saville Center.

b. National Fair Housing Month

Mayor Noble proclaimed April 2016 as "Fair Housing Month" in Stillwater, Oklahoma. Stillwater Housing Authority Executive Director Glen Redding accepted the proclamation and thanked City Council for their continued support of public housing.

**7. PUBLIC HEARINGS**

- a. Receive public comment regarding the proposed City of Stillwater operating budget for fiscal year 2016-17

City Manager Norman McNickle stated that this is the second public hearing regarding the proposed fiscal year 2016-2017 operating budget.

Mayor Noble opened and closed the public hearing as no one was present for or against.

No action was taken on this item.

**8. GENERAL ORDERS**

- a. Consider proposed amendments to Form Based Codes (CC-16-40)

Director of Operations John McClenny reported that since the adoption of Form Based Codes, some issues have been identified. The proposed amendments are to bring the Form Based Codes into compliance with City Standards, to provide unique and proper designs of the street for use by multi transportation modes, to ensure adequate provision for parking in the area and establish a method for voluntary annexation of surrounding properties into the Corridor Redevelopment Area.

Staff recommends that the proposed amendments be referred to the Planning Commission for the April 5, 2016 meeting.

Discussion occurred regarding the width of travel lanes, bike lanes and sidewalks; the visibility of storefronts in the pictures shown with center street parking; the reduction in conflicts between the different transportation modes; and the need for some flexibility in the Form Based Codes.
