

RESOLUTION NO. CC-2016-13

“A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF A TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) GRANT APPLICATION FOR IMPROVEMENT OF SIDEWALKS AND CROSSINGS ASSOCIATED WITH THE “6TH AND PERKINS CONSTRUCTION PEDESTRIAN DETOUR ROUTE” IN STILLWATER, OKLAHOMA.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Stillwater approves submission of an application to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation’s Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) project funding for 2.6 miles of sidewalk and crossing improvements on City and State Right-of-Way located in the corporate limits of the City of Stillwater; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stillwater is a local unit of general purpose government that will facilitate the receipt of TAP funds if the City of Stillwater is awarded the funding; and

WHEREAS, the 6th and Perkins Pedestrian Detour Route will improve the city pedestrian/bicycle access and enhance safety and curb appeal for sections of East 12th Avenue, South Lewis Street, East 3rd Avenue, East 6th Avenue, South Perkins Road, East 8th Avenue, and South Burdick Street.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILLWATER, that the City Council authorizes submittal of an application to the Transportation Alternatives Program for the 6th and Perkins Construction Pedestrian Detour Route Project.
