SUPPLEMENT TO: Street Name Change Request

In 2005, the City Council changed the name of Payne Street in the 6th Section of the Wedgewood Addition to North Wedgewood Street. Due to a number of issues brought to the attention of City staff from the residents along this street, a request has been made to change the name to North Wedgewood Drive.

The concerns identified by the residents include:

1. Whenever residents order something online and give an address as Wedgewood St., the vendor's system changes or tries to change the address to Wedgewood Dr.
2. Neighbors experienced problems with limo services not finding the address because all the GPS systems refer to our street as Wedgewood Dr. not Wedgewood St.
3. All of us living along this section of Wedgewood St. wonder if emergency services such as EMTs, Firemen, or Police would be able to find our location due to the way GPS lists our street as Wedgewood Dr. not Wedgewood St.
4. Finally, those living on this section of Wedgewood St. feel greater continuity throughout the entire Wedgewood Addition would result if our street name was changed to Wedgewood Dr. reflecting its name in the older sections of the Wedgewood neighborhood.

Staff has made the following findings:

1. Notice was provided to all property owners on North Wedgewood Street.
2. No objections to the street name change have been received.
3. City staff supports the street name change.
4. The street name being requested is the presumed street name currently.
5. Any current issues with emergency vehicles locating the correct address should be remedied.

Resolution CC-2016-19 is on the agenda for approval.
