1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Mayor Noble called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Keke Abai, 5th grader, and Mwende Abai, 1st grader, at Westwood Elementary School, led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. PROCLAMATIONS & PRESENTATIONS

- a. Distinguished Young Woman of Payne County Ana Teresa Atilas

Mayor Noble proclaimed May 16, 2016 as "Ana Teresa Atilas Day" in the City of Stillwater. Distinguished Young Woman of Payne County for 2017 Ana Teresa Atilas thanked the City of Stillwater for supporting the Distinguished Young Woman program and stated she looked forward to giving back to the community through her endeavors with the program.

7. GENERAL ORDERS

- a. Consider sale of City owned property at 301 S. Washington Street (CC-16-60)

Special Projects Director John McClenny reported that the City had purchased the property in 2008 with funds from the Transportation Sales Tax at a cost of \$475,000. The property was to be used as right-of-way for connecting 3rd Avenue from Hester to Washington. The transportation project was cancelled and is no longer viable. The purchase price included a building that was demolished to accommodate the planned street extension. The property is being used as a paved parking lot, with eight public parking spaces. With the demolition of the building, the property value is expected to be less than the original purchase price. Staff recommended that City Council declare the property surplus, sell it at public auction and return the proceeds to the Transportation Sales Tax Fund for use on other transportation projects. Discussion occurred regarding use of the paved lot, dedicated fund use, value of the property and the process to sell the property. Mayor Noble requested parking fee numbers and appraisal value of the property be brought to City Council
