1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Mayor Noble called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

2. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Stillwater City Council led the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. GENERAL ORDERS

- a. Consider Parking Steering Committee report on downtown parking

Special Projects Director John McClenny presented the downtown parking report generated by the Parking Steering Committee. Mr. McClenny introduced the members of the Parking Steering Committee, all of whom were present for the meeting. Mr. McClenny displayed a parking dilemma triangle portraying the challenge of balancing the convenience, expense and quantity of parking. Downtown parking needs and parking management system options were reviewed. Recommendations by the Parking Steering Committee for the downtown area are as follows:

- Future development may require additional parking in the future;
- No additional parking facilities needed at present without commercial/residential development in the area;
- A parking management system should be considered to make best use of existing parking; and
- Send concept of parking management system to the BID #1 Advisory Board for consideration and discussion prior to a final decision by City Council.

Discussion was held and City Council directed staff to begin discussions with the BID #1 Advisory Board regarding a parking management system, examine cost of implementing a city-wide parking management system, research parking management systems in other college cities, specify what parking revenues would be spent on and explore revisions to parking related fines.

- b. Report on parking options for property at 301 S. Washington Street

Special Projects Director John McClenny reported that the eight parking spaces at 301 S. Washington Street could produce annual revenue of \$23,000 calculated at \$1.00 per hour for eight hours a day. If the parking spaces were rented, annual revenue could be \$2,800 to \$3,200. A business locating on this property would generate more in sales tax revenue. The appraisal process has begun and should

be complete within four weeks. A decision regarding the property will be made following receipt of the appraisal.
