**WHEREAS**, during Ammie's leadership, the Sherrar Museum of Stillwater History and the Oklahoma WONDERtorium were honored for their partnership in presenting "How Oklahoma Began" as the Outstanding Education Program in the State of Oklahoma by the Oklahoma Museums Association; and the Museum was also honored by the Oklahoma Historical Society as the outstanding local history museum for 2013;
