Purpose: Bid Recommendation for FY 18 Pavement Markings

Budget Impact: The FY18 budget contains adequate funding for the project. There are no expected changes or impacts to the budget with the recommended bid award.

Prior Council Action or Part of an Approved Project: No

Related Items: None

Alternatives: The following alternatives are available to Council:

1. Award a contract in the amount of \$71,846.24 to Action Safety Supply for the Base Bid.
2. Award a contract in the amount of \$112,647.66 for the Base Bid and the Add Alternate Bid.
3. Reject the bids.

The cost of the Base Bid and Add Alternate Bid exceeds the budgeted amount of funding for this project.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the Council award the contract in the amount of \$71,846.24 to lowest responsible bidder, Action Safety Supply Co., authorize staff to execute the contract documents and authorize expenditures in an amount not to exceed \$79,031 for the completion of the project.

Background Information: The base bid for this project includes University Avenue from Western Road to Knoblock Street, 3rd Avenue from Knoblock Street to Perkins Road and the intersections of 6th Avenue and Western Road, 6th Avenue and Monroe Street, and 6th Avenue and Husband Street. Since the bid opening, Oklahoma Department of Transportation has placed new pavement markings at the intersections, so that portion of the work will be removed from the contract with an estimated savings of approximately \$19,400.
