For three decades, I served as an instructor at colleges and universities. In the early years of that span, I earned graduate degrees in English: an M.A. from Northeastern University in Boston and a Ph.D. from the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee. The last eighteen years were devoted to teaching at OSU in Stillwater. Many of my classes focused on training students to utilize a library's resources--from the traditional locating of books and journal articles to current techniques in online and database searching--in order to find evidence for academic essays. As of this year, though, I have left teaching to concentrate on writing and editing my own books while transiting into a career at a public library. My desire is to expand upon what I've been teaching students by helping people of all ages to benefit from their library.
