Background / Issue:	<p>On October 7, 2019, City Council approved Resolution No. 2019-19, authorizing the update of the city of Stillwater’s multi-hazard mitigation plan.</p> <p>The City of Stillwater Emergency Management department has contracted with Meshek & Associates to re-write the City of Stillwater Hazard Mitigation Plan and applied for and received a hazard mitigation grant from FEMA to pay 75% of the \$156,000 cost for the plan. FEMA will reimburse the City of Stillwater \$117,000.</p>
Proposal/Solution:	Emergency Management is seeking approval of the attached budget amendment appropriating funds to begin the re-write of the hazard mitigation plan.
Financial Impact/Funding Source(s):	The cost for the hazard mitigation plan is \$156,000, of which FEMA will reimburse the City \$117,000 (75%).
Related Strategic Priority:	#3 Safe Community: To identify effective services that enhance relationships, responsiveness and quality customer service to promote a safe and secure community.
Recommended Action/Motion:	Motion to approve budget amendment to appropriate funds to begin the re-write of the hazard mitigation plan.
