<b>Agenda Item:</b>	7b. CC-21-19
<b>Background / Issue:</b>	The Oklahoma Arts Council (OAC) received \$3 million of CARES Act funding and made funds available to Oklahoma agencies who serve diverse populations with art based missions that enhance the quality of life.
<b>Proposal/Solution:</b>	Stillwater Community Center applied for this grant and was awarded \$15,000. These funds will be used to replace lost revenue from live theater, special events, and musical acts that were canceled due to Covid-19.
<b>Financial Impact/Funding Source(s):</b>	A budget amendment reflecting the grant revenue of \$15,000 is attached.
<b>Related Strategic Priority:</b>	#1 Effective Services & Accountable Government: To provide effective services and accountable government for all citizens by practicing fiscal responsibility, transparency and outstanding customer service.
<b>Recommended Action/Motion:</b>	Motion to accept the grant from the Oklahoma Arts Council and approve a budget amendment reflecting the \$15,000 grant revenue.
