Program Overview

Due to COVID-19, a large number of residents have experienced financial hardship.

In December, City Council appropriated \$150,000 of CARES funds towards the Stillwater Resident COVID Assistance Program to help with utility, rent, or mortgage payments.

Timeline

- ◎ Our Daily Bread opened applications on Monday, **December 21**.
- ◎ **Two days** and **244** submitted applications later, ODB paused the applications to provide time to review each application.
- ◎ By **January 15**, all **\$150,000** had been awarded.



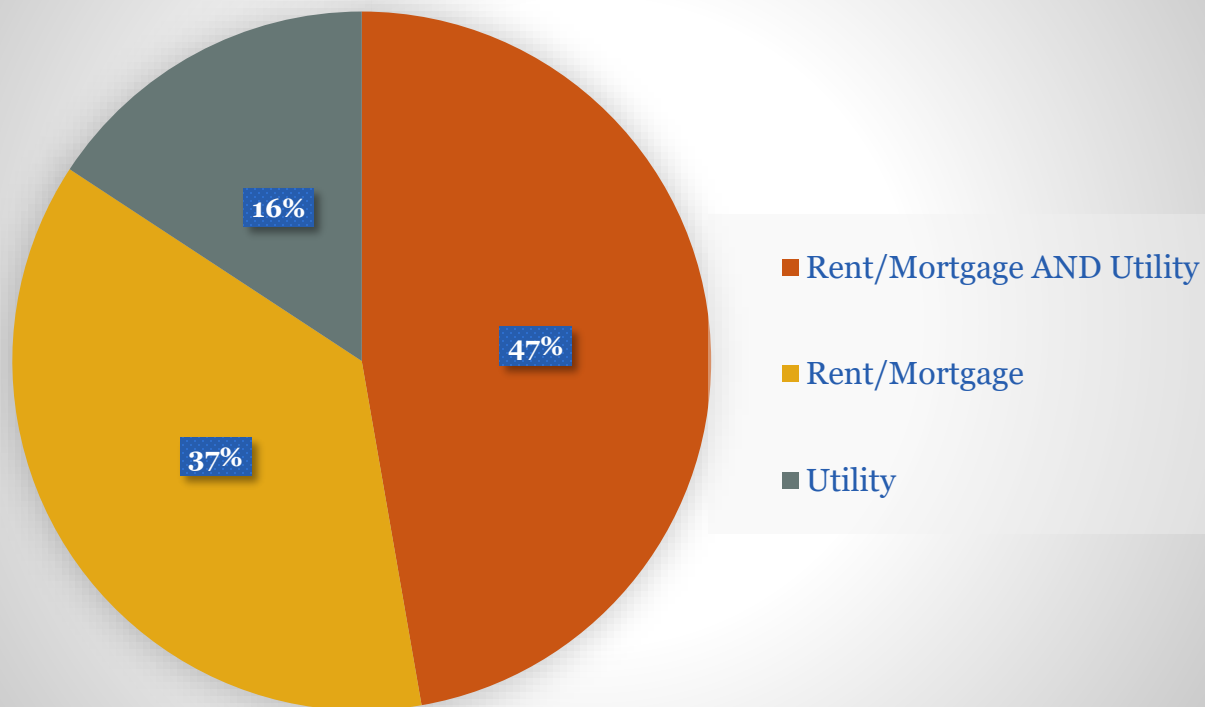
◎ **318** applications received
(some were duplicates)

◎ **146** applications approved

◎ Average household size
awarded: **2.73**

◎ Utility: 23 applicants

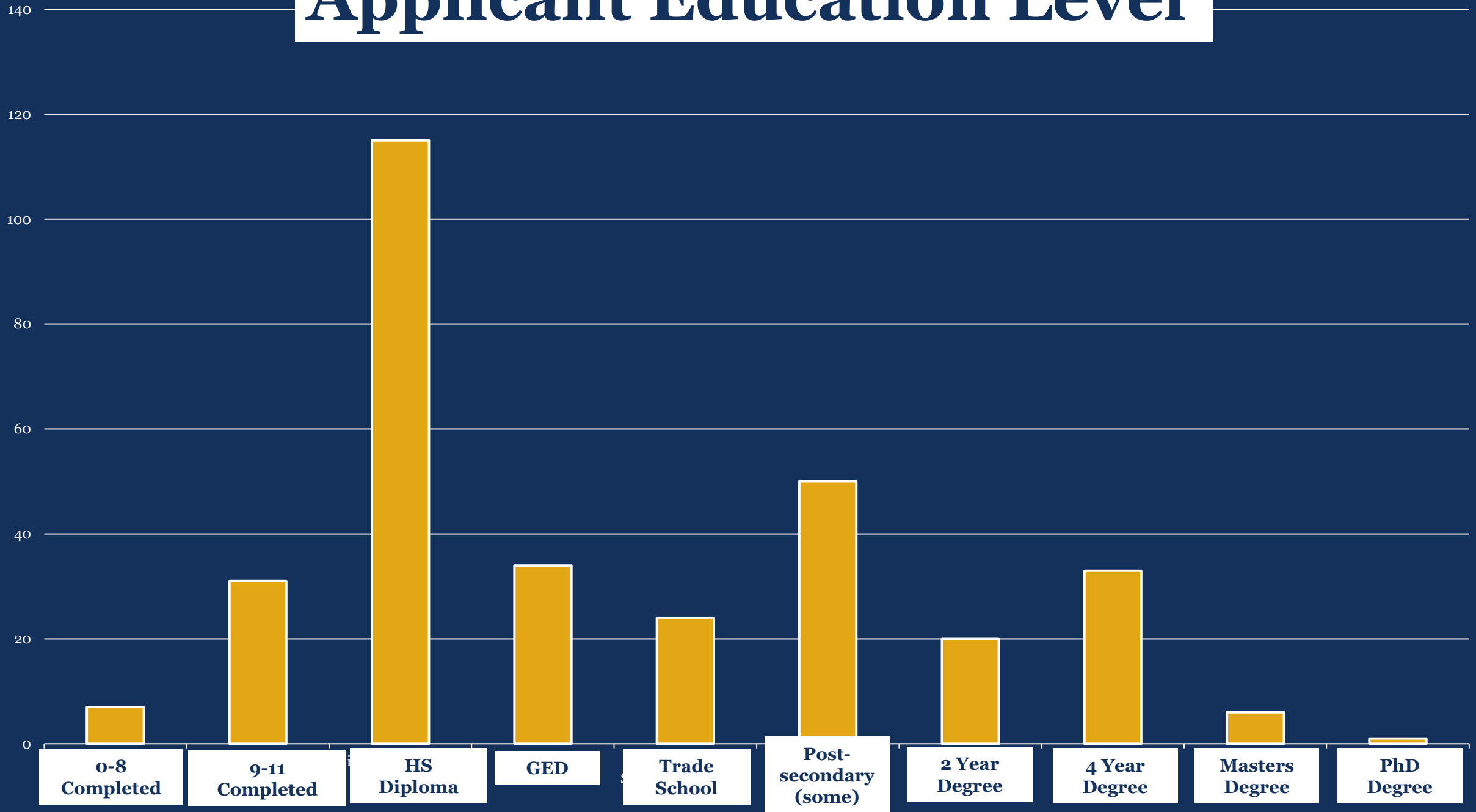

Top reasons applicants were denied:

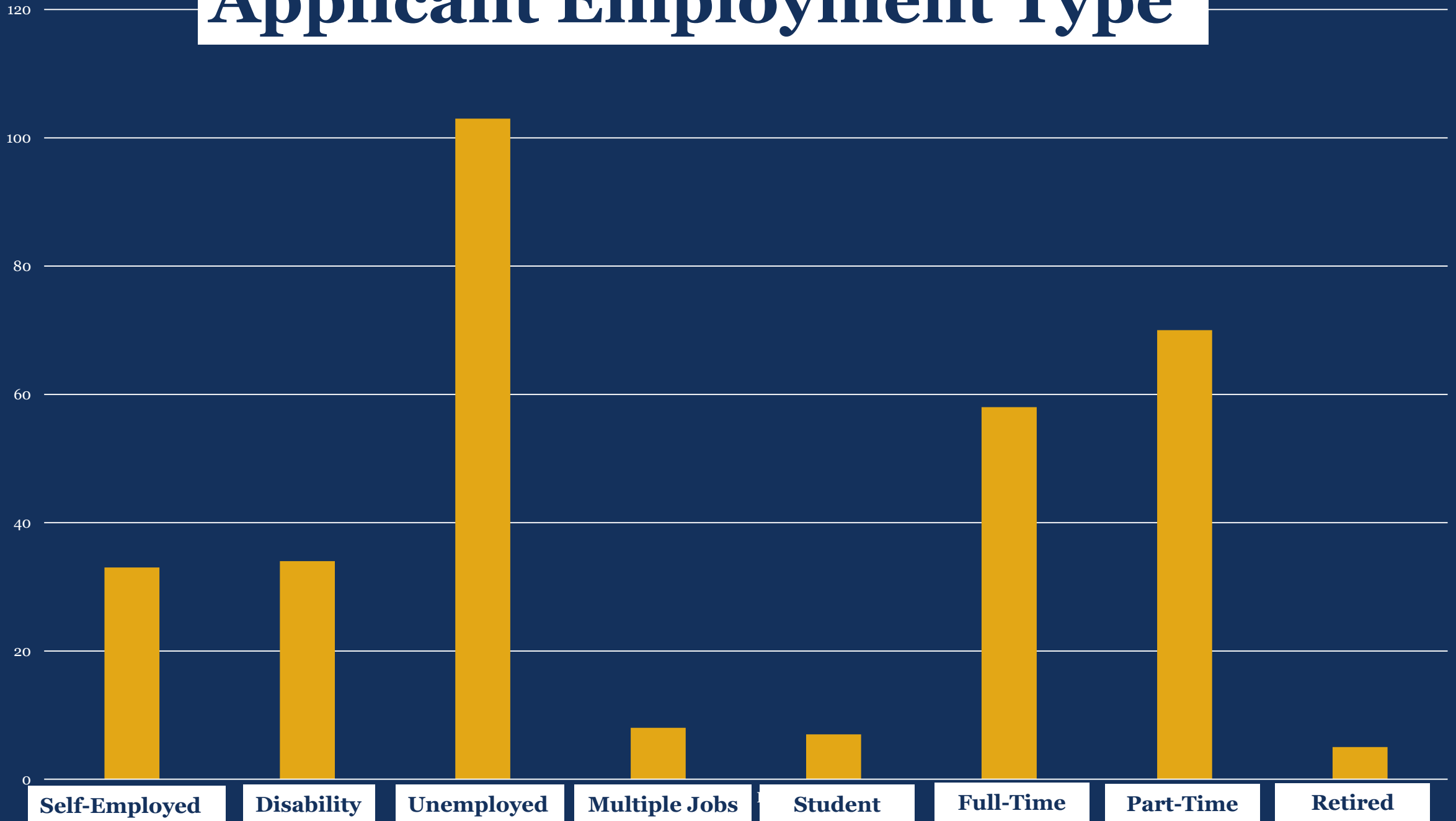
- ◎ Not a COVID impact: **93**
