Background / Issue:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May 3, 2021 Council held the public hearing regarding the 2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application, took citizen input and project suggestions. • Council selected the Stormwater Drainage Project for 12th Avenue between Duck and Duncan. • City Engineering has prepared a project cost estimate of \$468,464.
Proposal/Solution:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff is recommending acceptance of the final grant allocation of \$228,333 as funded by U.S. Housing & Urban Development through the Oklahoma Department of Commerce and approval of the budget amendment appropriating the match allocation and additional project funds from the Transportation ½-cent Fund.
Financial Impact/Funding Source(s):	\$240,131 from the Transportation ½-cent Fund in match funds.
