Background / Issue:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Charles Edward Johnson II and Crystal Nicole Johnson request acceptance of an electric easement at 3111 S Sangre Road. • The easement is part of a residential site that is located within the city limits and is on the northeast corner of W 19th Avenue and S Sangre Road.
Proposal/Solution:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Acceptance of an easement is routine and there are no practical alternatives. The proposed electric easement requested contains 1,862 square feet, (0.043 acres).
