

**RESOLUTION NO. CC-2021-25**

"A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF A COVID-19 VACCINATION INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR STILLWATER RESIDENTS"

WHEREAS, the City of Stillwater has received federal CARES Act reimbursement funds;  
and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that \$50,000 of the funds received from the CARES Act reimbursement should be allotted for incentives for the vaccination incentive program;  
and

WHEREAS, Stillwater Medical Center has donated \$50,000 to be used as incentives for the vaccination incentive program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Stillwater has received a donation of two (2) OSU football tickets for four (4) home games to be used as incentives for the vaccination incentive program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that providing a vaccination incentive program serves a public purpose.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILLWATER:

Section 1. The City Council hereby creates the "COVID-19 Vaccination Incentive Program for Stillwater Residents" and adopts the program requirements, rules and administration attached hereto.

Section 2. The City Council has directed the transfer of \$50,000 from the CARES Act reimbursement for administration in accordance with this resolution and adopted program requirements.

## Background

The City of Stillwater (COS) in collaboration with the Stillwater Medical Center (SMC), Stillwater Chamber of Commerce, and Visit Stillwater are encouraging all citizens to become fully vaccinated against COVID-19 in effort to safeguard our healthcare professionals and help save lives.

Healthcare professionals at SMC and throughout our community continue to give every effort fighting this debilitating and deadly virus. Healthcare professionals are dealing with extreme exhaustion and critically short-staffed facilities. Yet they remain resolute on the front line battling this virus.

Stillwater and Payne County citizens are asked to become fully vaccinated against COVID-19 in effort to show our healthcare professionals that we value their lives as they have sacrificially and heroically valued ours. To further encourage vaccination participation, a drawing has been added to the campaign as incentive.

## Contest & Drawing Dates

The contest begins on Tuesday, August 17 and ends on Thursday, September 30, 2021. The drawing will be on Friday, October 1, 2021.

## Eligibility & Program Rules

City of Stillwater and Payne County residents with a Stillwater address may be eligible to participate in the contest drawing if they present the two entry requirements [listed below], along with their photo identification card, in-person to the Stillwater Chamber of Commerce (409 S. Main Street, Stillwater, OK 74074) or Visit Stillwater (2617 W. 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Stillwater, OK 74074). Parents/legal guardians may have an additional entry into the drawing by showing COVID-19 vaccination(s) verification card for their child(ren) who are 12-17 years in age.

The two entry requirements to be presented when entering the drawing are:

- Proof of residency (current utility statement or lease agreement with participant's legal name included), address must be located within Stillwater corporate city limits or Payne County with a Stillwater address; and
- Proof of started or completed COVID-19 vaccination(s) any date prior to Thursday, September 30, 2021.

Only one entry per person except as described above, duplicate entries are not allowed. City of Stillwater employees are not eligible to participate in this drawing.

After eligible proofs are verified, participant information (name, address, and phone number) will be written on a ticket and secured for the drawing on Friday, October 1, 2021.

## Prizes

(20) \$5,000 cash prizes (15 within Stillwater corporate city limits and 5 within Payne County with Stillwater address)

(4) Pair of Club-level tickets to Oklahoma State University Football home game

## **Get Vaccinated**

**COVID-19 vaccinations are free and available to the public now.** Vaccinations are available through the health department, many local retail pharmacy stores, and some doctor's offices. To locate a vaccination location nearest you, go to: <https://www.vaccines.gov/>.

## **Prize Drawings**

The drawings will be Friday, October 1, 2021, at 5:30 p.m. live on television (AT&T U-verse channel 99 or Suddenlink channel 14) and the City of Stillwater Facebook page (follow us @CityOfStillwater). As an additional effort to prevent the spread of COVID-19, participants can not attend the drawings in-person.

## **Obtaining Prize**

After the live drawings, each winner will be contacted the following business day with details on how to receive their prize. All winners must be fully vaccinated to receive their prize. A 1099 will be completed for each winner. Prizes will be held until Friday, November 5, 2021 for those still completing the vaccination series. Prizes not picked up by that date will be foregone.

All prize winners are subject to final verification.
