1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Mayor Noble called the Stillwater City Council meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.
Chairman Marc Tower called the Stillwater Regional Airport Authority meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

2. GENERAL ORDER ITEMS

A. Staff presentation on Air Service Agreement and Air Service Availability Agreement

City Attorney John Dorman presented highlights of the "Air Service Agreement" with American Airlines. The agreement provides for commercial jet air service to Dallas-Fort Worth Airport twice daily beginning August 23, 2016. It includes a "minimum revenue" guarantee that requires City financial participation if passenger loads do not meet certain thresholds set forth in Schedules I and II, and caps this obligation at \$3.2 million over the term of the agreement. Mr. Dorman added that the agreement also contained a two year waiver of landing and facility fees, requires marketing assistance, and purchase of certain "airside" equipment. He noted that a separate agreement with Oklahoma State University and a Federal grant provide funding to offset part of the revenue guarantee and these costs. The agreement does have a 30-day reciprocal "out clause" if the expected passenger volumes do not materialize.

Mr. Dorman next discussed a companion "Air Service Availability Agreement" between the City and Oklahoma State University. He explained that under this agreement, OSU will make up to \$1.5 million available to fund the revenue guarantee set forth in the Air Service Agreement if needed.

B. Stillwater Regional Airport Authority discussion and vote on recommendation to City Council regarding the Air Service Agreement and Air Service Availability Agreement.
