Background / Issue:	The Oklahoma State University Flight School has been an airport tenant for well over 30 years. In addition to basing more than 30 aircraft at our airport, the flight school makes up in excess of 60% of our annual airport operations. Over the last year, OSU has worked with the Airport and City of Stillwater to explore where, on the airport property, a new flight center could be located. It has mutually been decided the best location will be on the south side of the airfield as depicted in the attached conceptual site plan.
Proposal/Solution:	The conceptual site plan will allow this body to make a decision on the use of the general area proposed.
Financial Impact/Funding Source(s):	This conceptual site plan, if approved, will outline the general location of the new facility. Once a final design, Federal approvals and a ground lease are approved, this facility will be a source of revenue for the airport.
