1. CALL MEETING TO ORDER

Chair Noble called the meeting to order at 6:05 p.m.

2. CONSENT DOCKET

- b. Bid recommendation for lubricating oil which will be used to provide lubrication to the engines and generators at the Stillwater Energy Center (SUA-16-21)
- c. Amendment to the City of Stillwater / GRDA agreement by amending the gas index used to calculate energy payments in the GRDA agreement to be consistent with the Stillwater Utility Authority's gas supply agreement for the Stillwater Energy Center (SUA-16-20)

5. GENERAL ORDERS

- a. Contract approval – Phase II of Fiber Optic Network Installation for the Stillwater Energy Center (SUA-16-19)

Generation & Transmission Division Manager Loren Smith reported that the northern loop of the fiber optic network is currently under construction by Trace Technologies and is expected to be completed in June 2016. Staff is preparing to move forward with Phase II of the fiber optic network and requested that Trace Technologies submit a proposal for the construction of Phase II. The pricing for the southern loop is \$5,350 less per mile than the northern loop and covers a much larger area. Trace Technologies would begin construction of Phase II immediately after the completion of Phase I. Mr. Smith reported that this item requires a new appropriation and budget amendment; and funding is available in the Electric Rate Stabilization Fund.

Staff recommends that Trustees authorize staff to enter into a contract with Trace Technologies for the installation of Phase II, the southern fiber optic loop, in the amount of \$1,150,000 and authorize expenditures from the Electric Rate Stabilization Fund up to \$1,265,000 (includes a 10% contingency).

MOTION BY TRUSTEE NAJERA, SECOND BY TRUSTEE ZANNOTTI TO AUTHORIZE STAFF TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TRACE TECHNOLOGIES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF PHASE II, THE SOUTHERN FIBER OPTIC LOOP, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,150,000 AND AUTHORIZE EXPENDITURES FROM THE ELECTRIC RATE STABILIZATION FUND UP TO \$1,265,000, WHICH INCLUDES A 10% CONTINGENCY.
