Subject: Urban Area Boundary Map

Purpose of Report: Adopt the urban area boundary map and authorize the Mayor to sign the map.

Background: After the decennial census, state and local officials have the opportunity to adjust each urban area for the purpose of transportation planning.

Discussion: To distinguish between urban and rural areas, the U.S. Census Bureau establishes urban areas based on the census data after the decennial census. That information is provided to the state for the state and municipal officials to evaluate and possibly adjust the Census Bureau's urban area boundary. Once ODOT officials and the city agree with the proposed changes, a map with the adjusted boundary is prepared and presented to the City, ODOT, and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for adoption. Once adopted and signed by the respective bodies/agencies, the maps become legal documents from which transportation planning decisions are made.

The map has been reviewed by staff and found to be proper

Recommendation: Staff recommends the Council adopt the urban area boundary map and authorize the Mayor to sign the map.
