Status: General Orders

Purpose: Inform Council of the grant allocation for the 2017 Community Development Block Grant and request project selection

Background Summary: On April 17, 2017 a public hearing was held for the purpose of public input on the project selection for the 2017 CDBG. Three eligible projects were presented and can be reviewed in the report linked below. (CC-17-56)

Budget Impact: The CDBG 2017 grant allocation is in the amount of \$121,127. The minimum required grant match is \$121,127. Staff recommends the selection of the Strickland Park improvements at a projected cost of \$350,000. The City's match is comprised of funds from the following sources:

Skate Park Improvement Project - \$146,032 – General Fund
Recreation Supplies - \$1,934 – Coca Cola Donation Fund
Recreation Supplies - \$50,451 – Park Donations
Recreation Site Improvements - \$30,456 – General Fund

A resolution authorizing leverage of the funds is on this agenda for approval.
