Background Information: The Emergency Shelter Grant is funded through the Dept. of Commerce and is a federal Housing & Urban Development program. Payne County Youth Services is applying for \$50,000 in grant funds, which require a 1:1 match. The intended uses of the grant funds include transitional living, emergency shelter, rapid rehousing, prevention, and other related services.
