Background Information: The Emergency Shelter Grant is funded through the Dept. of Commerce and is a federal Housing and Urban Development program. Stillwater Domestic Violence Services is applying for \$50,000 in grant funds, which does require a 1:1 match. The intended uses of the grant funds include emergency shelter, rapid rehousing, and homeless prevention.
