

Sec. 27-32. Compliance with laws and regulations.

A person holding a parade permit shall comply with all permit directions and conditions and with all applicable laws and ordinances.

Sec. 29-274. Dangerous objects in streets.

(a) No person shall throw or deposit upon any highway, street, avenue or public thoroughfare any glass bottle, glass, nails, tacks, wire, cans or any other substance likely to injure any person, animal or vehicle upon such highway, street, avenue, or public thoroughfare.

(b) Any person who drops, or permits to be dropped or thrown, upon any highway, street, avenue or public thoroughfare any destructive or injurious material shall immediately remove the same or cause it to be removed.

(c) Any person removing a wrecked or damaged vehicle from a highway, street, avenue or public thoroughfare shall remove any glass or other injurious substance dropped upon the public thoroughfare from such vehicle.

(d) No person shall throw any substance at a vehicle or any occupant thereof nor shall any person throw any substance at a person on or adjacent to a highway, street, avenue or public thoroughfare.

Sec. 29-8. Obedience to police and fire department officials.

No person shall willfully fail or refuse to comply with any lawful order or direction of a police officer or fire department official.
