

**PROCLAMATION WITHDRAWING AND RESCINDING**  
**DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY**  
**MAY 14, 2021**

WHEREAS, Chapter 14 of the Stillwater City Code and Titles 21 and 63 of Oklahoma Statutes empowers the Mayor of the City of Stillwater to proclaim a civil emergency when a natural disaster, which results in the death or injury of persons to such an extent that extraordinary measures must be taken to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of the City; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned Mayor issued an Emergency Proclamation dated February 26, 2021 invoking certain measures to protect public health and safety during the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, said proclamation was extended by a proclamation dated April 29, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the conditions set forth in said Emergency Proclamation have improved to a level that the measures set forth in said order can be safely be withdrawn and rescinded.

NOW, THEREFORE, BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME BY THE STILLWATER CITY CODE AND STATE LAW, I, WILLIAM H. JOYCE, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF STILLWATER, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM AND DECLARE:

SECTION ONE: The Proclamation Declaring State of Emergency dated February 26, 2021 as extended on April 29, 2021 is hereby withdrawn and rescinded effective immediately.


